Studies focus on adolescents in high risk families. Responsibilities include collaboration with multi-disciplinary research teams and multi-site studies. Professional development opportunities include publication, grant submission, and advanced quantitative classes. Required: PhD (or ABD) in Social Science Discipline with expertise in Quantitative Methods, MPH with expertise in Quantitative Methods, or PhD (or ABD) in Statistics with a demonstrated interest in behavioral science. Expertise in longitudinal modeling techniques is also required. Expertise in multilevel modeling and categorical data analysis are desired.
