Senior Researchers

- Two Senior Researchers are needed to independently design and manage large-scale, highly visible, multi-year research and evaluation projects. The starting salary of a Senior Researcher is \$58,000.
- These positions require a Ph.D. in a social science related field, as well as advanced and specialized evaluation and research skills and experience.
- They also requires experience independently managing clients, developing business, and managing large project teams, as well as experience supervising multiple staff.
- Senior Researchers monitor research quality across multi-year project phases, including startup, data collection, analysis and reporting. This includes monitoring and addressing ethical, methodological, and analytic issues encountered on projects.
- Technical understanding of research methods and analytic techniques is required.
 - For one position, a background in Participatory Action Research focusing on community-based processes is preferred.
 - For the other position, a background in health disparities is preferred.

Researchers

- Multiple Researchers are needed to assist with a range of evaluation efforts and independently lead evaluation projects. Some of these positions require more experience and management than others. Therefore, the starting salary for each position depends on qualifications. Please include salary requirements with your cover letter.
- Five years experience in social science research is required. Completion of a Master's degree is preferred, and some positions require a Ph.D.
- Researchers provide oversight of work performed by research assistants, data managers and data entry specialists. Researchers also develop scopes of work including budgets, deliverables and deadlines, and communicate with clients about project status and budget.
- Applicants should have experience managing projects and/or people, as well as strong analytic and writing skills.
- The content areas vary across positions. It is preferable for applicants to have experience in at least on of the following areas:
 - ◆ Health disparities
 - ◆ Youth Development
 - ◆ Participatory Action Research and community-based processes
 - ◆ Criminal and juvenile justice
 - ◆ HIV-related research and evaluation
