We currently have multiple full-time positions open. Researchers

- Multiple Researchers are needed to assist with a range of evaluation efforts and independently lead evaluation projects. Some of these positions require more experience and management than others. Therefore, the starting salary for each position depends on qualifications. Please include salary requirements with your cover letter.
- Five years experience in social science research is required. Completion of a Master's degree is preferred, and some positions require a Ph.D.
- Researchers provide oversight of work performed by research assistants, data managers and data entry specialists. Researchers also develop scopes of work including budgets, deliverables and deadlines, and communicate with clients about project status and budget.
- Applicants should have experience managing projects and/or people, as well as strong analytic and writing skills. Some positions require advanced skills in either qualitative or quantitative data analysis.
- The content areas vary across positions. It is preferable for applicants to have experience in at least one of the following areas:
 - ◆ Health disparities
 - ◆ Criminal and juvenile justice
 - ◆ Youth Development
 - ◆ Participatory Action Research and community-based processes

Research Assistants

- Two Research Assistants are needed for project support. A minimum of a BA/BS in a social science or related field is required and one to two years research experience is preferred. The starting salary for Research Assistants is \$30,000/year.
 - One Research Assistant is needed to conduct follow-up interviews with people who have received substance abuse treatment services. The primary responsibilities for this position include obtaining client contact information, scheduling and conducting in-person interviews, entering follow-up data into web-based system, and maintaining other relevant documentation. This person must be comfortable interviewing marginalized populations, including IV drug-users. Traveling throughout the Denver-metro area, as well as some evening and weekend work is required.
 - The other Research Assistant position focuses on a wide variety of tasks that include the implementation of data entry protocols, data collection, data management, literature review support, basic quantitative analysis, and client product development support, such as reports and manuals.
