The Society for Research in Child Development has announced that SRCD Policy Fellowships will be available for 2004-05. The deadline for applications is December 15, 2003. SRCD Policy Fellows - in both Congressional and Executive Branch placements - work as "resident scholars" at the interface of science and policy. The goals of these fellowships are: (a) to contribute to the effective use of scientific knowledge in developing public policy, (b) to educate the scientific community about the development of public policy, and (c) to establish a more effective liaison between scientists and the federal policy-making mechanisms. SRCD Fellows participate with other scientific disciplines in the fellowship programs of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. Both early and mid-career professionals are encouraged to apply.
