2. FUNDING OPPORTUNITY: HIV PREVENTION IN MINORITY COMMUNITIES

The Collaborative HIV-Prevention Research in Minority Communities Program offered by the UCSF Center for AIDS Prevention Studies and sponsored by the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD) and the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) invites applications from Scientists/Researchers in tenure track positions and investigators in research institutes who have not yet obtained RO1 funding from the NIH or an equivalent agency. The Collaborative HIV Prevention Research in Minority Communities is designed to assist Scientists/Researchers improve their programs of research and obtain additional funding for their work, with the purpose of increasing the numbers of ethnic minority group members among principal investigators at NIH, CDC, and other equivalent agencies. Investigators from the UCSF Center for AIDS Prevention Studies collaborate with scientists to develop an ethnic minority-focused HIV prevention research project. Participants will: (a) receive mentoring and \$25,000 to conduct their preliminary research; (b) spend six weeks in San Francisco for three consecutive summers; (c) receive a monthly stipend for living expenses and roundtrip airfare to San Francisco each summer.
