Position Summary:

Qualifications:

An earned doctorate in epidemiology or related field with a focus on some aspect of population health is required. An MPH is desirable. A research record appropriate for the rank with a focus on epidemiology and population health is required, as well as, funding or the potential for developing extramural funding. The ability and desire to do collaborative research within the University is important. Demonstrated excellence in teaching is expected. Teaching responsibilities will include graduate and undergraduate level courses in areas such as, epidemiology and thesis supervision.
