The Health Promotion Department at the School of Public Health at the University of Haifa is seeking Ph.D. and postdoctoral candidates to work on a funded project on adolescent substance use. The successful applicants will work on international and time trend data from the Health Behavior in School Aged Children Survey (HBSC). More specifically the project is designed to analyze social and cultural factors related to adolescent substance use across countries and over time.

The position involves statistical data analysis (Structural Equation Modeling and Hierarchical Linear Modeling) and preparing manuscripts for publication. Experience in conducting independent quantitative research and preparing publishable manuscript drafts of research results is a strong plus.
