- **Bachelors degree in Statistics, Psychology, Epidemiology, Public Health, Economics, or related area with 3 years of experience using one or more statistical software packages (SAS, R, SPSS, etc.) and Excel or a Masters degree in the same areas with 1 year of relevant experience with the above mentioned software packages**

- **Ability to manage small and large datasets, create codebooks, manipulate data (e.g., variable creation), move and merge data files from different platforms, clean and aggregate data and perform quality control**
