Description: Virginia Commonwealth University is seeking an Assistant Research Professor (non-tenure track) in the Commonwealth Institute for Child and Family Studies (CICFS). CICFS is the research institute of the Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (<http://www.cicfs.vcu.edu/>). The candidate will have experience researching the causes, prevention, and treatment of child, adolescent, and young adult mental disorders, including substance abuse. The candidate will join ongoing research with departments of Psychiatry, Pediatrics, Epidemiology, Psychology, and Surgery as well as with city health departments focusing on the social ecology of adolescent substance use, primary care interventions, mobile phone interventions, treatment outcomes research, and violence prevention. Relevant teaching experience is valued. Clinical experience useful.

The Department of Psychiatry is a robust clinical, educational, and research organization with over 80 full-time faculty. The Department houses the Virginia Institute for Psychiatric and Behavioral Genetics which performs multidisciplinary research in genetic causes of psychiatric illness (<http://www.vipbg.vcu.edu/aboutus.shtml>).
