JOB DESCRIPTION

The Department of Criminology and Criminal Justice at the University of South Carolina invites applications for two tenure track positions to begin Fall 2012. Position 1 will be filled at the rank of Assistant Professor, and position 2 will be filled at the rank of Associate Professor. We seek candidates with a Ph.D. in criminology or criminal justice, but applicants with an earned doctorate in a related social science discipline will be considered. Applicants who are close to completing their degrees may be considered for the Assistant Professor position (1), but it is expected that the degree will be in hand prior to the date of appointment. For both positions, area of specialization is open, but preference will be given to those applicants whose interests are consistent with the Department's orientation toward policy-relevant research and whose area of focus complements the current strengths of the Department. Applicants for position 1 should show clear promise of contributing important scholarly research and effective teaching. Applicants for position 2 must have an established record of excellence in scholarship.
