

Society for Prevention Research – Rapid Response Advocacy Action Items Procedures

The SPR Rapid Response Advocacy Action Procedure was implemented (November 2, 2017) as an action item of SPR Strategic Plan Goal 3.

Any SPR member may generate a proposal regarding a policy position which they think should be adopted and/or advocated by the Society. Frequently these are submitted to the SPR President who would forward to the chair of the Advocacy Committee. Not all proposals received will be considered; when a determination has been made to consider the proposal, the following process is followed. The Advocacy Committee will vote to determine if the proposal should be submitted to the SPR Board of Directors, and only the SPR Board of Directors has the authority to officially adopt a position.
